

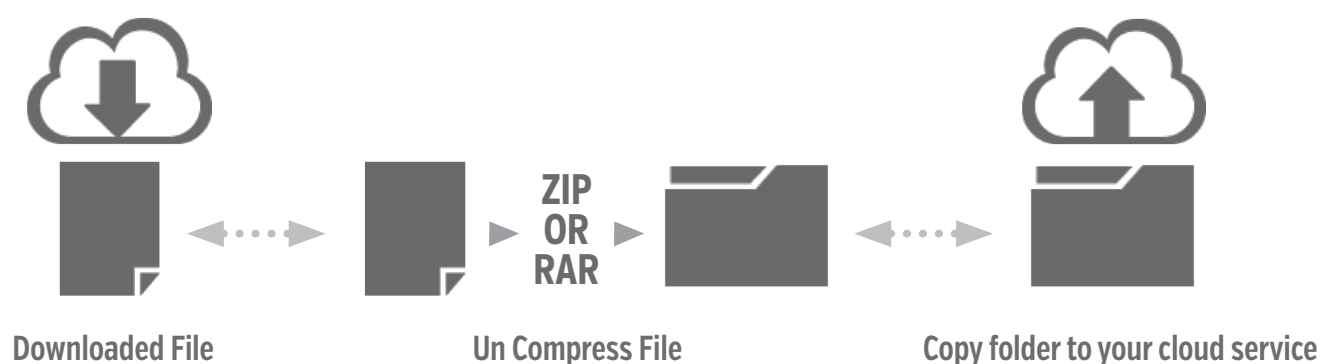

Installing Procreate brushes

There are a few ways to install brushes into Procreate, this is the way I have been installing brushes and seems to work well. Another way is to download the file directly to the iPad and use an app to decompress the files but I store my files on Drop Box so uploading them works easier for me and I have a back-up of my brushes.

1. DOWNLOAD FILE

Installing from Drop Box, iCloud or Google Drive



Download the file and un-zip (un compress) the file and upload the folder to Dropbox (recommended), an iCloud Drive or Online Google Drive. Be sure to copy the entire contents of the folder.

2. IPAD PRO INSTALL

Now you have your folder with your brushes in it loaded into Drop Box and you ready to transfer them to procreate and dive right into using them.

1. Open Procreate
2. Swipe up from the bottom to open app bar and press and hold to bring a small window and drop over procreate this will open a window from drop box and place it over Procreate.
3. Now select the top of the window and drag it to the left so you can open the brushes drawer in Procreate.
4. Open the brushes pallet and select NEW SET procreate will make a set labeled "Untitled Set" the name can be changed later by clicking the title.
5. In the window with Drop Box Navigate to the folder with the brushes that you uploaded, click "SELECT" at the top a check each brush to select it then press and hold, then drag them over to the "Untitled Set" that you made in procreate. And you done, enjoy your new brushes.
